- 1.1 **Event:** 2010 Jubilee Yacht Club Phil Small Race. Saturday, October 2.
- 2.1 **Eligibility and Entry:** Open to all boats with a valid 2010 PHRF-NE certificate. Classes will be standard MBSA classes. One-design classes may be added provided enough entries are received.

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form (web entry preferred) and paying the entry fee to Jubilee Yacht Club, P.O. Box 104, Beverly, MA 01915. Entries must be submitted before 1000 on Saturday, October 2. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

All JYC racing season pass holders are entitled to race at no further cost, but still need to submit an entry form.

Online entry will be available at www.jycracing.org.
- 3.1 **Fees:** \$40.00 less \$5 for USSA, and \$5 for MBSA.
- 4.1 **Rules:** The Phil Small Race will be governed by the Mass Bay Sailing Association General Sailing Instructions except as changed by the Phil Small Race Sailing Instructions (available at www.jycracing.org).
- 5.1 **Notices to Competitors:** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the lower hallway of the JYC.
- 7.1 **Signals Made Ashore:** Signals made ashore will be displayed on the JYC yardarm.
- 8.1 **Schedule of Races:** One ocean race will be held.
- 8.2 The warning for the first fleet will be 1200.
- 10.1 **Racing Area:** Salem Sound, in the vicinity of Curtis Point.
- 11.1 **The Course:** MBSA Standard Rounding Marks, Lists A & B or MBSA Standard Courses, using inflatable marks.
- 12.1 **Marks:** If MBSA Standard Courses are used the inflatable marks will be tetrahedrons or cylinders.
- 15.2 **Recalls:** The Race Committee will use VHF channel 72.
- 18.1 **Time Limit:** The time limit Shall be three hours from the start of each class. If no boats in that class finish within the time limit then the race shall be abandoned for that class. The time limit may be extended by the Race Committee on VHF 72.
- 27.1 **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded for the first and second place finishers in each class.
